As the retail director of a fine Swiss watch-maker, Jean-Philippe needs to look impeccably tailored. We made him a classic two-button, two-piece tuxedo in dark blue with a black shawl lapel - a look that would pass muster at any Oscar Awards ceremony. We completed the look with a pleated white shirt and black bow-tie. Finally, we added a touch of class with a white silk pocket square folded in a simple puff.



- The lining shouldn't draw attention to itself. We opted for midnight blue. Avoid loud and colourful.
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- Four fabric-covered buttons slightly overlapping are *de rigeur* on a tuxedo.

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A plain white silk pocket square with a simple puff fold is perfect. Avoid patterned or coloured versions at formal events. It's innapropriate.
